<p>12:10</p>	<p>HAPPY BIRTHDAY BARBRA STREISAND</p> <p>Barbra Streisand: One Voice This benefit concert at Streisand's Malibu ranch opens with an emotional rendition of "Somewhere" and includes "People," "The Way We Were," and "Happy Days are Here Again." In between songs, she talks about the environment and other political issues during a year which the Democratic Party recaptured control of the Senate. Also with a performance Streisand gave at the 1993 Presidential Inaugural Gala and a 1992 appearance on <i>Saturday Night Live</i> where she shared the stage with Mike Myers, Roseanne, and Madonna. <p>3:25</p>	<p>Lost: "Pilot"</p> <p>This pilot in this fantasy drama series about a group of plane-crash survivors forced to live with each other on a remote and mysterious island. Characters' past lives are told through frequent flashbacks. The series begins as a bruised man -- Jack -- awakens alone in a seemingly deserted jungle. After wandering around for a bit, Jack, a doctor, discovers the other survivors of a plane crash, now deserted on a remote island, and immediately goes to work trying to help injured people. Flashbacks show the events on the airplane prior to the crash. Jack meets fellow survivors: Kate, who quickly becomes his girl Friday; Hurley, a friendly cherubic fellow; and Charlie, a one-hit wonder former rock star. With strange, guttural noises emanating from the jungle, Jack and two others embark on a cross-island journey to search for the cockpit of the plane, and potential escape from the isle.
