1:25	<p>HAPPY BIRTHDAY HUGH LAURIE</p> <p>House: "Three Stories" House's ex-wife Stacy (Sela Ward) shows up for the first time in five years and dumbfounds House when he learns that she is now married. (2005; 45 minutes)</p>
2:15	<p>IN MEMORIAM: ANN B. DAVIS (1926 – 2014)</p> <p>The Brady Bunch: "The Show Must Go On" It's Family Frolics night at the high school -- a talent show for students and their parents. Marcia talks Carol into performing a routine with her while Greg strong-arms Mike into collaborating on their own number. Meanwhile, Alice and Sam (Allan Melvin) are going through a typical lovers' quarrel. (1972; 26 minutes)</p>
2:40	<p>Bradymania: A Very Brady Special This special, hosted by Florence Henderson, takes a fond look back at "The Brady Bunch," a situation comedy series about a widow with three daughters who marries a widower with three sons. The special focuses on footage from the 1969-1974 series; the show's huge success in reruns; its subsequent cult following; and its current status as a part of American popular culture, equally loved and lampooned. 3:40	<p>HAPPY BIRTHDAY JOSHUA JACKSON</p> <p>Fringe: "The Transformation" When the Fringe Division investigates another strange occurrence aboard an international jet, macabre remains are discovered at the crash site. Memories lead the team toward some promising clues, but the overall picture remains elusive. John Noble, Anna Torv. (2009; 45 minutes)</p>
4:25	<p>HAPPY BIRTHDAY ADRIENNE BARBEAU</p> <p>Maude: "Maude Meets Florida" Maude -- who has trouble keeping maids because she comes on too strong -- hires Florida Evans (Esther Rolle), who agrees to take the job on a trial basis for one week. At the end of the week, Florida decides to quit because she can't cope with Maude's overzealous efforts to treat her like an equal, but Carol and Walter convince her to talk to Maude to iron out their differences.
